Supports young people who have housing issues and require support for their legal issues (such as conflict with the law, court, exiting the justice or child protection systems, victim support) to transition to independence. This program can help young people's views be heard, find somewhere to live, learn to live independently, support at court, and work towards goals.

This program works with young people and their family – but only with the agreement of the young person. They help rebuild relationships, put strategies in place at home, and with other goals and needs. There is also a more intensive Family Partnership service which works with families of young people on bail or a Youth Justice order within Brisbane North.
